### DISCLOSURE OF POSITION STATEMENTS AND TRANSPARENCY: WHERE ARE WE NOW?

We are delighted to offer an **online** session delivered by Eliza Sharron of 39 Essex who was junior counsel in the recent Court of Appeal case of Re Gardner (Deceased) (Court of Protection: Disclosure of Position Statements) [2026] EWCA Civ 640, overturning Poole J's approach in Re AB (Disclosure of Position Statements) [2025] EWCOP 25 (T3).

**Eliza Sharron** specialises in complex Court of Protection health and welfare proceedings, including serious medical treatment, cross border cases, and cases where there is an overlap with the inherent jurisdiction. Eliza has a background in family law and has a special interest in cases involving the deprivation of liberty of children or young people.

Eliza advises and acts in associated civil, public law and human rights claims arising out of the above, including breach of Article 5 and 8 and claims relating to children (for example, failure to remote/unlawful removal/unlawful use of section 20).
