PROPERTY AND AFFAIRS CASE LAW UPDATE FOLLOWED BY PANEL Q & A

Fay is a specialist Court of Protection and chancery barrister. She has a broad practice that encompasses contentious probate, trusts, property disputes and all sides of Court of Protection work. Early 2020 saw some big changes for the world of court of protection with the judgements in Re ACC and PLK & Ors having an impact on the way that Deputies practice.
