



Reforming the Law of Wills: In association with the Law Commission

The Law Commission published its consultation paper "Making a Will" in July 2017. The consultation closes on 10 November 2017.

The law relating to wills largely relates back to the Wills Act 1837. Join us for a lively discussion within a workshop format and to have your say on the proposed amendments to:

- The test for testamentary capacity (*Banks v Goodfellow* or change to MCA 2005 for all cases);
- The test for statutory wills – does the best interest test in s.4 MCA 2005 work;
- Supported will-making – is this desirable or feasible;
- Formalities – advantages and disadvantages of change and of allowing for electronic wills;
- Protecting vulnerable testators – should there be a statutory doctrine of testamentary undue influence;
- Ademption and the disparity between disposals by an attorney and by a deputy.
